An invitation-only, one-day leadership simulation for senior clinical trial leaders with direct responsibility for Risk-Based Quality Management.

Why this event now

RBQM programmes do not fail because teams lack more dashboards. They fail when evidence, accountability and decision rationale do not connect during real study conduct.

Interpret the signal

Distinguish meaningful risk signals from noise, incomplete data, pressure and conflicting interpretations.

Act proportionately

Decide what should change in study conduct, and what should deliberately not be escalated.

Defend the decision

Reconstruct what was known, why the team acted or did not act, and where the evidence trail can be found.

Request an invitation

Programme faculty, venue, fee and package options will be announced by mid-September.

The Decision Room

A full-day, in-person simulation. Not introductory training. Not a presentation-led conference.

Designed for

VPs and senior operational leaders with direct RBQM ownership across Clinical Operations, Quality/GxP, Central Monitoring, Medical Oversight, Data/Analytics, sponsor oversight and CRO delivery.

Participation is limited to 45 people to preserve seniority, interaction and cross-functional balance.

Simulation arc

1. Interpret the signal

Teams receive a mixed evidence package: anomalies, deviations, delayed data, a possible safety pattern, recruitment pressure and AI-supported alerts.

2. Determine the intervention

Teams decide whether to change monitoring intensity, contact sites, escalate, challenge the CRO, revisit risk assessment or reject an AI recommendation.

3. Defend the decision

Teams reconstruct the evidence trail as if an inspection has begun: what was known, why action was taken, and whether it was proportionate.

FAQs

Is this a conference?	Most of the day is spent working through an evolving study scenario.
Are speakers confirmed?	Faculty is being developed and will be announced separately.
Is the venue confirmed?	The event will be in Frankfurt; the exact venue is still being finalized.
Is there a participation fee?	Fee and package options will be shared by mid-September at the latest.
Does requesting an invitation commit me?	It only signals interest and allows Cyntegrity to assess fit.
